Sustainable Forests (Timber Harvesting) Regulations 2006

S.R. No. /2006

1. Objectives

The objectives of these Regulations are to regulate the environmental aspects of timber harvesting by prescribing the following matters—

- (a) classes of timber harvesting operators licences;
- (b) activities or classes of activity for which a timber harvesting operator's licence is required;
- (c) an application fee for a timber harvesting operator's licence and renewal of a timber harvesting operator's licence;
- (d) a demerit points system in relation to timber harvesting operators licences, including—
 - (i) the circumstances in which demerit points are incurred; and
 - (ii) the procedures for notification to a holder of a timber harvesting operator's licence that demerit points have been incurred; and
 - (iii) the circumstances in which demerit points are cancelled; and
 - (iv) the process for reviewing a decision to give demerit points;
- (e) the maximum period for suspension of a timber harvesting operator's licence under Division 2 of Part 6;

(f) matters to be recorded by the Secretary in the register of timber harvesting operator's licences.

2. Authorising provisions

These Regulations are made under Division 2 of Part 6 and section 96 of the **Sustainable Forests** (Timber) Act 2004.

3. Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on 1 July 2006.

4. Revocation

The Timber Harvesting Regulations 2000 are **revoked**.

5. Definitions

In these Regulations—

- "Act" means Sustainable Forests (Timber) Act 2004;
- "demerit points" means points allocated in accordance with regulation 10;
- "timber harvesting operator" means a person who is a holder of a timber harvesting operator's licence issued under Division 2 of Part 6 of the Act:
- "relevant State forest" has the same meaning as reserved forest or protected forest in the Forests Act 1958.

6. Classes of timber harvesting operators

For the purposes of section 96(1)(c) and (d) of the Act, Column 1 of Schedule 1 sets out the prescribed classes of timber harvesting operators licences and Column 2 of Schedule 1 sets out the prescribed activities or classes of activity for

which a timber harvesting operator's licence is required.

7. Application fees

- (1) For the purposes of section 53(2)(c) of the Act, the application fee for a timber harvesting operator's licence is \$40 [to be reviewed].
- (2) For the purposes of section 55(2)(b) of the Act, the application fee for renewal of a timber harvesting operator's licence is \$40 [to be reviewed].

8. Circumstances in which demerit points are incurred

For the purposes of section 96(1)(a)(i) of the Act, the circumstances in which demerits points are incurred are when there has been a breach of any of the requirements of engagement in timber harvesting operations specified in Column 1 of Schedule 2.

9. Allocation of demerit points

Column 2 of Schedule 2 allocates demerit points in relation to breaches of the requirements of engagement in timber harvesting operations specified in Column 1 of Schedule 2.

10. Notice of Demerit Points Incurred

An authorised officer must notify a timber harvesting operator of the incurring of demerit points in the form of Schedule 3.

11. Notice of Request for Review of Demerit Points Incurred

If a licensed timber harvesting operator disputes the decision by an authorised officer to issue and serve on him or her a Notice of Demerit Points Incurred, he or she may send or deliver to the Secretary at the Regional Office of the Department of Sustainability and Environment specified in the Notice not more than 5 days after the service of the Notice of Demerit Points Incurred, a Notice of Request for Review of Demerit Points Incurred in the form of Schedule 4.

12. Review of demerit points incurred to be completed in 14 days

If a Notice of Request for Review of Demerit Points Incurred has been delivered to the Secretary at the Regional Office of the Department of Sustainability and Environment, the Secretary must review the decision in respect of which the Notice has been delivered within 14 days of delivery of the Notice.

13. Suspension of timber harvesting operators licences

For the purposes of section 61(1), the number of demerit points is the number of accumulated demerit points specified in Column 1 of Schedule 5 which correspond to the period of suspension in Column 2 of Schedule 5.

14. Notice of Suspension of Timber Harvesting Operator's Licence

For the purposes of section 61(3) of the Act, the Secretary must notify a timber harvesting operator of the suspension of his or her licence in the form of Schedule 6.

15. Notice of Cancellation of Timber Harvesting Operator's Licence

For the purposes of section 62(3) of the Act, the Secretary must notify a timber harvesting operator of the cancellation of his or her licence in the form of Schedule 7.

16. Notice of Request for Review of Suspension or Cancellation

For the purposes of section 63(2)(a) of the Act, the holder of a timber harvesting operator's licence whose licence is suspended or cancelled in accordance with the Act may send or deliver to the Secretary at the Regional Office of the Department of Sustainability and Environment specified in the Notice a Notice of Request for Review of Suspension or Cancellation in the form of Schedule 8.

17. Service of notices on timber harvesting operators

A Notice of Demerit Points Incurred or a Notice of Suspension or Notice of Cancellation must be served personally on the timber harvesting operator or be sent by registered post addressed to him or her at the address given by him or her on his or her application for a timber harvesting operator's licence or the last address subsequently notified to the Secretary.

18. Certificate of service of notices to be completed

If a Notice of Demerit Points Incurred or a Notice of Suspension or a Notice of Cancellation has been served on a timber harvesting operator, the person serving the Notice must—

- (a) complete the Certificate of Service endorsed on the duplicate of the Notice; and
- (b) if that person is other than the Secretary, send that Notice with the completed Certificate endorsed on it to the Secretary.

19. Secretary to review decision in relation to the incurring of demerit points and the suspension or cancellation of a timber harvesting operator's licence

In reviewing a decision in relation to the incurring of demerit points and the suspension or cancellation of a timber harvesting operator's licence, the Secretary may cancel, change or confirm the decision by the authorised officer to issue and serve on the timber harvesting operator the Notice of Demerit Points Incurred or a Notice of Suspension or a Notice of Cancellation.

20. Notification by Secretary of result of review

When the Secretary has completed a review of the decision, the Secretary must notify the timber harvesting operator of the result of the review in the manner specified in regulation 16 for the service of a Notice of Demerit Points Incurred or a Notice of Suspension or a Notice of Cancellation.

21. Register of timber harvesting operators

The Secretary must ensure that the qualifications, competencies or experience of the holder of any timber harvesting operator's licence are recorded in the register established by the Secretary under section 68 of the Act.

If you wish to dispute the decision of the authorised officer to issue and serve this Notice, you may complete a Notice of Request for Review of Demerit Points Incurred and deliver it to the Secretary at the Regional Office of the Department of Sustainability and Environment not more than 5 days after the date this Notice is served on you.
